Building Owner or Representative,

During inspections of the fire alarm and sprinkler system the technicians must have access to all components they inspect. I have attached copies of the codes that require this access. It is the owner or occupant (or their representative) who are responsible for allowing entry into the building and its spaces for these inspections. Spaces include any area that has fire alarm or sprinkler components. Some examples of these areas: mini-horns in residential spaces, sprinkler heads in residential spaces, devices in electrical and equipment rooms, and any other area occupied or un-occupied that have devices. Failure to comply can result in a citation. In addition the inspection will be required to be repeated until all devices are inspected. This can result in additional fees from the contractor for multiple inspection trips.

NFPA 25 1-4.1

The owner or occupant shall provide ready accessibility to components of water-based fire protection systems that require inspection, testing or maintenance.

NFPA 72 7-1.2

The owner or the owner's designated representative shall be responsible for inspection, testing and maintenance of the system and alterations or additions to this system. The delegation of responsibility shall be in writing, with a copy of such delegation provided to the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) upon request.
