3) Insurance Renewal

Chief had previously provided the 2021/2022 insurance renewal analysis for review and is seeking direction from the Board. The renewal information indicated several options, the option to renew the current plan realizes a 9.3% increase in premium while Alternate Plan 1 raises the stop loss (out of pocket maximum) by \$850.00 for family and increases the co-insurance from 10% to 20% with a 3.2% increase in premium cost. Following brief discussion, Board directed Chief to select renewal of the current plan for medical insurance.

4) Surplus

A thermal imaging camera, inventory ID 01020 is being submitted for surplus and disposal as it is no longer operable and out of service. **Motion** (5804) to deem the thermal imaging camera as surplus and authorize the Chief to dispose of in accordance with Florida Statute 274.06 made by Commissioner Louwers, second Commissioner Langford... carried.

5) Executive Report

Executive Report was previously submitted. Chief informed that he wished to make aware, identified replacement of staff vehicle next year, because of limited supply of vehicles have been advised to order vehicle in advance. If not appropriated through the budget, we can cancel the order. Chief Comer added that after speaking with Commissioner Walker, he is no longer needing the presentation as all of his questions were answered. Iona-McGregor Fire District Executive Report

Executive Summary/ August 2021:

GENERAL:

- Interviews conducted with 3 candidates for the Facilities Manager position. An offer was made to an individual who is in the pre-employment process now and will be starting ASAP.
- We are moving forward with a process to fill the Division Chief of Training and Special Operations position in the 2021-2022 fiscal year. The plan is for the successful candidate to begin early in October.
- AC Comer has been preparing an accreditation presentation as directed at last months meeting. Since then, the questions that some had which prompted the presentation have been answered. Is the Board direction still to proceed with a presentation? Quarterly reports on the Strategic Plan and the Standards of Cover performance will be presented moving forward.

OPERATIONS:

- We have made conditional job offers to ten (10) new firefighters who will conclude orientation by the beginning of September.
- Lieutenant promotional testing orientation was held on August 9th and five (5) candidates will participate.
- Three (3) of our firefighters, (1) one Lieutenant, and (2) engineers have concluded their hiring/promotional (1-year) probationary period.
- Numerous personnel and progressing with acting out of classification training (Engineer or Lieutenant).
- Organizational interest in joining special operations disciplines continues.

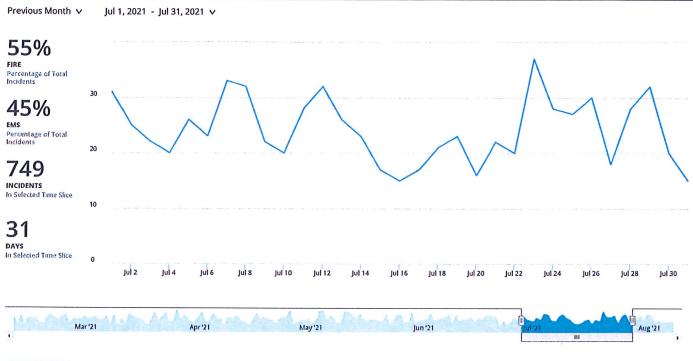

Executive Summary/ Sept. 2021:

GENERAL:

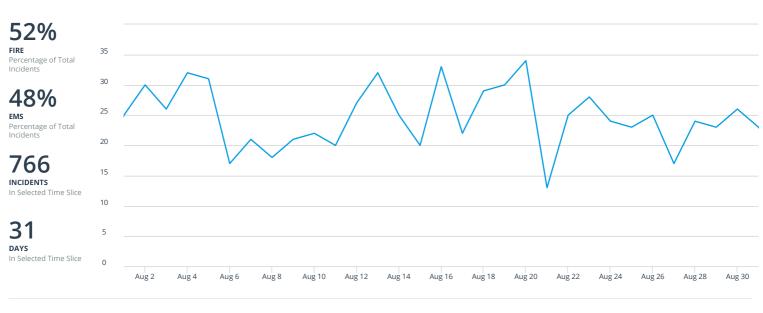
