Business Agenda Items (Agenda Items Requiring Action)

1) Meeting Minutes – November 17, 2021 Hearing no necessary adjustments to presented minutes, a **motion** (5826) to approve minutes of November 17, 2021, was made by Commissioner Barbosa, seconded by Commissioner Langford... carried.

2) Financial Report – November 2021 After brief discussion regarding interest rates. Commissioner Walker requested CFO Winzenread to send the State's listing and statute for public depositor requirements. Following discussion, **motion** (5827) to approve November 2021 financial report was offered by Commissioner Barbosa, second Commissioner Langford... carries.

3) Capital Assets
CFO Winzenread described the capital asset recommendation adding that it is desired that the
Board formally adopt the recommended changes to the District's capital asset listing of recorded
property for the purposes of compliance with DFS Rule 69I-73. Following discussion, three
separate motions were made to accomplish this.

First, a **motion** (5828) to formally adopt as the District's list of recorded property for the purposes of DFS Rule 69I-73, exempting items valued from \$1,000 to less than \$5,000 from the District's capital asset listing effective September 30, 2021, was made by Commissioner Barbosa and seconded by Commissioner Langford... carried.

Then, **motion** (5829) to authorize the removal of all items from the District's capital asset listing that have an original cost of less than \$5,000 and are fully depreciated effective September 30, 2021, was made by Commissioner Barbosa, seconded by Commissioner Andersen... carried.

Finally, **motion** (5830) to approve the automatic subsequent removal of the remaining items that have an original cost of less than \$5,000 as they become fully depreciated from the District's capital asset listing was made by Commissioner Barbosa with a second offered by Commissioner Langford... carried.

4) Executive Report

Commissioner Walker questioned the 90% roof completion, what building? Deputy Chief Guzman informed that the repair is to the training tower. Commissioner Walker then inquired as to the Tower 74 buck repair that was submitted to insurance for apparatus, what is for? Assistant Chief Comer described the accident resulting in apparatus damage as well as the follow-up investigation. Following discussion, **motion** (5831) to accept the Executive Report made by Commissioner Walker, second Commissioner Andersen... carried.

5) Attorney Report

Attorney Pringle briefly addressed the business agenda question from Commissioner Walker pertaining to Public Recognition, informing the board adopted the current agenda format. Commissioner Walker asked attorney to bring board up to date on proposed new station. Mr. Pringle responded that the District has interest in acquiring a piece of property to construct a better located Station 72. Chief Howard, Assistant Chief Comer and attorney have been working on site selection and have not brought anything to board as nothing has met our criteria and been available for purchase. Some sites could be used however improvements would need to be made. A potential site has been discussed but is not currently on the market. The owner is aware of district's needs to construct new fire station better located in the circle of influence and we are awaiting response from property owner. Following discussion, **motion** (5832) to accept Attorney Report made by Commissioner Andersen, second Commissioner Barbosa... carried

DVP Wright informed that all was good. DVP Mascarelli was not in attendance. **Motion** (5833) to accept DVP Reports as submitted was made by Commissioner Barbosa, second Commissioner Langford... carried.

## **Executive Summary/ December 2021:**

### **GENERAL:**

- TAP program representatives were here last week for their site visit. Staff worked with them over three days to review what has been done thus far in the Strategic Plan, Community Risk Assessment-Standard of Cover, and the Self-Assessment writings.
  - We will soon receive a written report with suggestions on things that should be addressed prior to moving forward with accreditation.

### **OPERATIONS:**

- Our probationary hires from August just completed their 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and associated module competency testing.
- We have Battalion Chief and Engineer promotional processes planned for late January and early February, respectively.
- Lee County Sheriff Office has initiated renewed discussion and planning for active shooter training.
- Hurricane season has officially concluded and now we anticipate the start of our dry season.
- Seasonal population has just about peaked and is obvious throughout our district.
- We responded to multiple structure fires in November and our commitment to training is apparent.
- Through the work of DC Wisdom, we look forward to more acquired structure training opportunities.

## Logistics:

- Station and Tower painting has been completed.
- Tower construction of new windowsills and protective coverings to top floor have been ongoing. Windows are now done, and roof is 90% complete.
- T74 bucket repair has been submitted to insurance. The insurance company has approved the repairs needed.
- We have moved forward with the FLIR thermal camera purchase for M70
- Apparatus are beginning to be sent to SFEV for their annual maintenance.
- Station office furniture replacement is ongoing. Should be finalized this week.
- Fuel system data input has begun.




## Fire Training/Special Operations:

### Liabilities

Liabilities totaling \$32,080 consist of trade accounts payable and amounts withheld from employees' pay for retirement, insurance and other voluntary payroll deductions.

### Notable items on the Statements of Revenues and Expenditures:

### Revenues

- Received approximately \$13.5 million in ad valorem tax revenues during the month of December. To date we have received almost 89% of the annual budged total.
