In our ongoing efforts to enhance and streamline our services, we have updated the fire inspection fee schedule. The fee schedule has not been updated since 2012. This adjustment was necessary to meet the growing demands of our community while continuing to provide the highest level of fire safety. The revised fee schedule will help support the necessary resources, training, and equipment required to operate the Prevention Bureau.

The implementation of the new fee schedule will begin March 1, 2024. As part of the revision of the fee schedule, we have added a nominal fee for the inspections of existing occupancies. We understand the significance of these inspections in safeguarding your homes and businesses, and we are committed to maintaining the utmost transparency regarding any associated fees.
