Adoption of Meeting Agenda, Including Amendments: A motion to 'Adopt Meeting Agenda, Including Amendments' was made by Commissioner Andersen, seconded by Commissioner Louwers...Motion carried. Call and question, all in favor aye.

<u>Approval of Previous July Board Meeting Minutes</u>: A motion to approve 'July Meeting Minutes' as listed was made by Commissioner Barbosa, seconded by Commissioner Andersen...Motion carried. Call and question, all in favor aye. Discussion ensues related to the tax collector. Commissioner Walker discusses expenses related to turnout gear; Division Chief Hernden elaborates on the service. Early projections of carry forwards are discussed between Commissioner Walker and CFO Winzenread.
